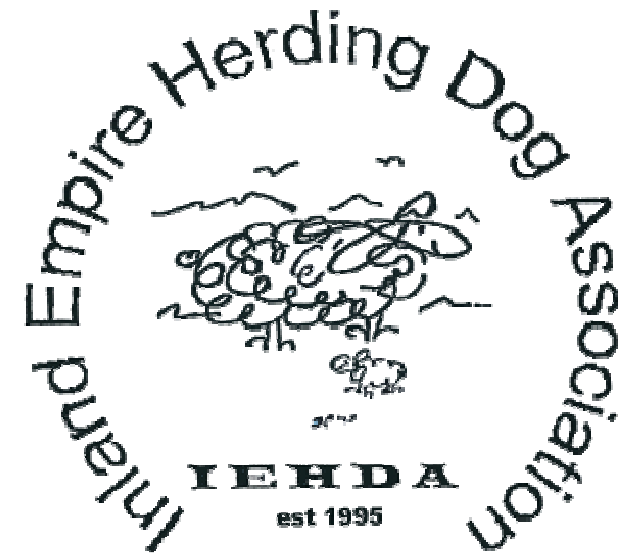

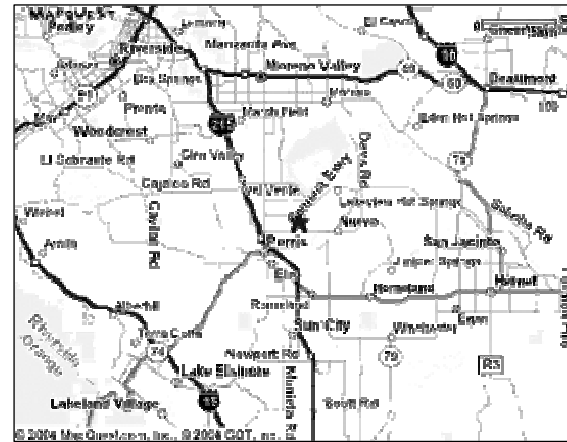

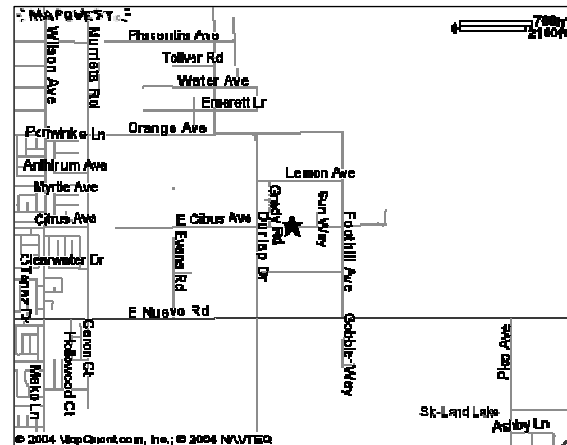

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money; ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold AHBA, Stoner Enterprises, this club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog, where such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury; be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property; arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in the Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property maybe caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or maybe alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of any injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury; or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

I (we) acknowledge that while the AHBA may provide sanctioning of this event, it does not have and does not exercise control over the conduct of the event or those present I (we) certify and represent that the dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to this event is/are not a hazard to other dogs, other animals, or to people.

## AHBA TEST/TRIAL PROGRAM

A dog may enter competition at any level for which it is trained.

No degree is prerequisite for another.

The AHBA herding trial program allows herding dogs and their trainers to demonstrate herding skills at three levels of herding training. The levels are designated by the prefix HTD for "Herding Trial Dog" followed by the numerals indicating the dog's level: HTD I, HTD II, or HTD III. For each level, a dog must earn two qualifying scores under two different judges.

A dog which has earned one leg toward the HTD II degree may not compete at the HTD I level ON THAT TYPE OF STOCK; a dog which has earned one leg toward HTD III may not compete at the HTDII level ON THAT TYPE OF STOCK. Dogs may not be entered in both novice and intermediate/advanced level classes on the same kind of stock on the same day.

For the first leg HCT tests, dogs need not have had prior herding training, but should have had training to come reliably when called; basic training to sit, down or stand-stay is highly recommended, as is prior supervised exposure to livestock. Second-leg test will require that the dog have had some basic herding training.

Titles are earned separately on different types of stock, with two legs being required, under two different judges, for the title on that particular type of stock. The type of stock on which the title was earned will be indicated by use of small initials after the titles: 's' for sheep, 'd' for ducks, 'g' for goats, 'c' for cattle. Titles on different types of stock may be earned concurrently or consecutively, at the same level or at a different level.

A dog may be excused at any time for unnecessary roughness, over-running of stock, or lack of control. The dog may be excused for non-productive work after 5 minutes.

Sponsors of sanctioned tests/trials shall pay a recording fee of \$2.00 per passing dog for those dogs to be recorded by the AHBA.

## ADDITIONAL TEST/TRIAL REGULATIONS

We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping keep the Test/Trial location as clean as possible in order for us to retain the use of this facility for future Test/Trials.

No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entries must be received at the Trial Secretary's address by the published closing date to be acceptable, and may not be changed, substituted, corrected, signed or cancelled after that time except as provided in Chapter 3, Section I of

the General Rules for Herding Tests and Herding Trials. Incomplete, unsigned, conditionals, telephone, telegraph, or entries received without fees are not acceptable. RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will assess a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent from the same exhibitor may result in their being put upon a cash-only basis.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian, judge or tester or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Dogs must be ready for their classes. Test/Trial judges have the authority to refuse to judge any dog that does not appear within five minutes of being called for its run. The Test/Trial-giving Club and the Test/Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authority, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulation will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

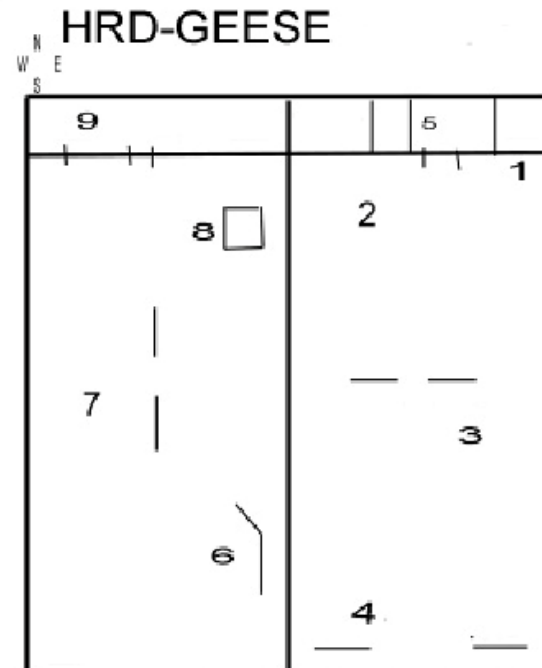

## IEHDA HRD Geese

1. GATHER--Geese are set out approx 20' off NE corner on grain. Dog is to collect geese and take to handler's post (#2) which is 150 feet away from set out. This is a gather, and stock may be brought along the fence line.
2. DRIVE 1--Stock are taken FROM post #2 and through freestanding panels #3, turned and taken from E to W thru panel #4.
  - Level 3 handlers may not pass panel #3.
  - Level 2 handlers may not pass beyond 20 from NE corner of panel 4.
  - Level 1 may fetch. Approximately 200' drive.
3. FETCH BACK--Stock are turned, brought back thru freestanding panels #3 and into pens (handlers may be anywhere)
4. SORT—marked stock
  - Level 3: sort marked goose using holding pens.
  - Level 1 and 2: any goose.
5. ARENA 2--Put all stock back together and transfer thru several small pens (closing all gates) and enter arena 2.
6. Y CHUTE--Take stock thru Y chute on NE side of arena 2.
  - Level 3: must drive from back fence.
  - Level 2: may come up to centerlines
  - Level 1: may drive or fetch, but may not go through obstacles
7. CENTERLINE--Turn geese, transit centerlines going from W to E
8. PEN--Put geese in freestanding pen in arena
9. RE PEN—Re pen into small gate at NW corner of Arena 2.



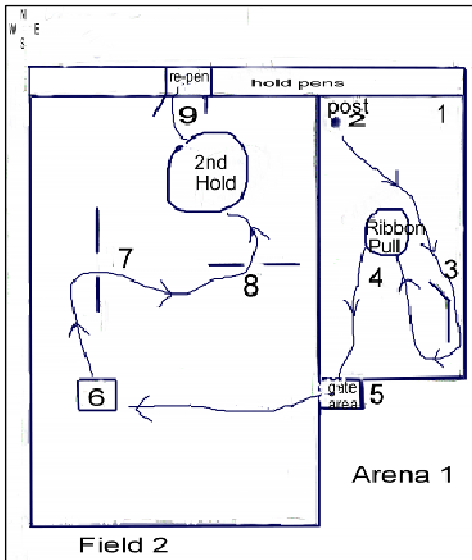

## IEHDA HRD Sheep

1. GATHER--Stock are set out approx 20' off NE corner on grain. Dog is to collect Stock and take to handler's post (#2 on map) which is 150 feet away from set out. This is a gather, and stock may be brought along the fenceline.
2. Drive 1--Y chute--Stock are taken FROM post #2 and through Y chute on NE side of arena. Ideal is a diagonal. Fenceline shall be 2 point deduction.
  - Level 3 handlers must stay at post.
  - Level 2 handlers may go to center lines.
  - Level 1 may fetch. Approximately 230' drive. Handler may leave after stock exit the Y.
3. Ribbon Pull--Stock are turned, brought to open area. HTD 3 does ribbon pull. Level 1 & 2 do a hold.
4. Transit Gates--Exit Arena 1 and negotiate small chute area thru gates into field.
5. Field Pen--Settle stock and pen in freestanding pen
6. Panel 1--Exit pen and drive stock thru panels (#7 on map) going from W to E.
  - Level 3 must drive from pen.
  - Level 2 may walk in line from pen to panels 2 (#8 on map)
  - Level 1 may fetch.
7. Panel 2--Turn stock and transit panels #8 on map going from S to N.
  - Level 3 still at pen.
  - Level 2 may not pass panels until after stock transit
  - Level 1 may drive or fetch but may not go through panels
8. Hold--Stock are HELD, preventing running to re-pen, in open area between panel 2 and re-pen.
- 9 RE-PEN--Re-pen thru gate at N end of arena
